

## Writing paragraphs

### Parts of a paragraph

1. Topic sentence - first sentence in a paragraph, introduces the main idea  
- gives the reader a clear sense of the content  
- contains words or phrases called 'controlling ideas'
  
2. Supporting details - after the topic sentence  
- "body" of a paragraph → give details to develop the main idea of the paragraph (facts, examples, ...)
  
3. Closing sentence - last sentence of a paragraph  
(Concluding) - restates the main idea in different words
