Role Interview

These screenshots are from the opening of the film.

The opening <u>sets the scene</u>. It tells the viewer about the place and the time of the action. This is called the <u>setting</u>. Look closely and work out what you learn about place and time.

The viewers also learn about the <u>characters</u> ['---], what they want and their relationships.

Looking at these screenshots here, work out what you learn about these characters and what they are after.

Task 1 (before viewing the clip)

- a) Work on your own. Imagine being the [one of the characters]. Look at the <u>screenshots</u> one by one. Try and "remember" what happened where, when, how and why.
 - Moreover, remember what you felt yourself and what [and some other character] did when [...].
- b) <u>Get together in pairs</u>. Tell the story to each other as you see it. Agree on a <u>storyline</u> that fits the screenshots best.
- c) <u>Stay with your partner</u>. Take on roles now. One of you is a "reporter" [for e.g. a radio station] who wants you to tell your story. Talk the story over together in questions and answers.
- d) Work on your own again now. Now both of you use the screenshots and in writing tell the story in the past tense from [your character's] point of view.
- e) Start like this: ["At first I thought it was my lucky day.../ It was on a sunny afternoon in May.../ in the middle of the night when suddenly..."]
